



Route from Moot Hall to Bunyan's birthplace.

By car to Bumpy Lane; Turn Left out of Moot's car park. Then Left onto Elstow High Street. 50 metres on, follow bend to Left, onto West End.

At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto West End (B530). 100 metres on, go into Left filter lane then turn Left onto A6. Follow A6 southwards, over one set of traffic lights, to big roundabout – turn Left and join A421 eastbound.

Take the first exit off A421, signed A600. In the slip road, get into the right hand lane. At the first mini-roundabout, take the third exit – A600. At the second mini-roundabout, take the First exit – A600. Go down a short hill and take the First turning Right – Old Harrowden Road.

Drive West, to the end of Old Harrowden road. Park on the grass area, beside the old farm buildings on the south side of the road. On the other side of the road is the gated entrance to Bumpy Lane.

Walk about 100 metres NNW, along Bumpy Lane and, immediately after crossing a small brook, on your left you will see a black gateway into a field. (Walking directions resume in **green**, below.)

On foot from Moot to Bumpy Lane; Leave Moot car park, to High Street, cross over and walk south. Cross the side road (Bunyan's Mead) and the path splits. Take the left fork, past No.28 (former Smithy). Path turns left (east). Continue east for about 250 metres, with Elstow brook on your right.

Path crosses a concrete access road and becomes an un-surfaced track, with Elstow brook still on your right.

Stay on this track for about 800 metres, with the brook on your right (the width of the gap between track and brook varies). At the T junction with Bumpy Lane, turn right (south) onto Bumpy Lane and follow it until you get to Abbey Fields road. (Path veers right just before the road)

Cross the road and bear left, go through the tubular metal vehicle barrier. Track descends a short slope, then bears right - into an underpass, under the A421. About 200 metres after the underpass and just before a small brook, on your right you will see a black metal field-gate.

From Bumpy Lane to the birthplace. Beside the black gate, there is a pedestrian access and a direction sign indicating the track to the birthplace. The track runs WSW along the edge of the field. *Please keep well away from any crops.*

After about 600 metres, you will come to a small outcrop of hedgerow, with an old stile jutting out into the field. Walk around that and the birthplace is immediately on the left.
